Simple moments like these are often some of the most enjoyable and help make the most of the summer months.

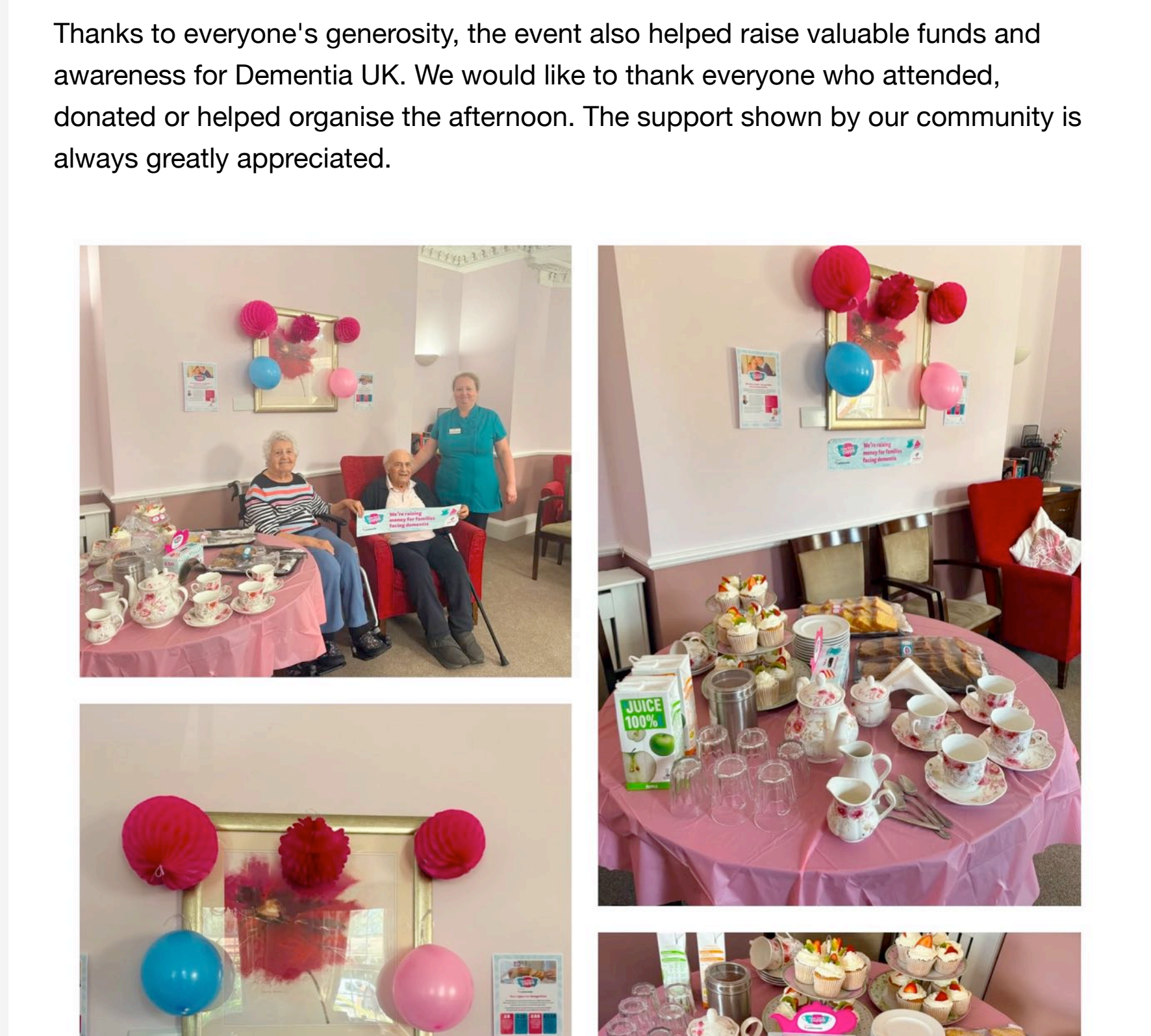


Time for a Cuppa
